We had to stay in our rooms at 10pm and got up at 6.30am.








ON TUESDAY

After the cruise, we went to the Sky Garden which is in the « Talkie-Walkie » This skyscraper measures 160 m and there are a restaurant and a bar at the top.






ON THURSDAY
